

Faculty of Social Sciences Policy on Meetings with Students

Brock University's Faculty of Social Sciences recognizes that the following principles guide all interactions between students and members of the University community such as faculty members, academic advisors, and other administrative staff:

- 1) Students have a right to maintain the confidentiality of their personal information which includes (but is not limited to) "academic information relating to the education, medical, criminal or employment history of the student." (Access to Student Records and Disclosure of Information Policy, approved March 2007)
- 2) Students attending any type of meeting with a member of the University community have a right to be accompanied by a member of the Brock community to assist them in representing their interests or advocating on their behalf. Legal representation is not allowed.
- 3) In the interest of the protection of personal information, other people such as family members are not allowed to attend meetings between students and members of the Brock community without prior arrangement.
